As I am sure some of you aware my name is Kieran and I will be heading up the Betting Systems Reviews for FTS. I am myself an FTS member and it is my intention to offer a clear and transparent service to the whole FTS Community.

Ian has made it clear to me he wants me to find products that will offer some value to the community and members, but also when I come across them, highlight the crap products that we find many marketing and scam artists trying to sell.

Ian has made it clear that transparency is paramount, this is a belief that I totally agree with by the way.

Over the coming weeks and months this will be an ever evolving beast and as we move along we will get everything very finely tuned. My aim is to make the FTS Website the No1 source of information for betting products and system reviews. It will take time but we will get there, I would ask for your patience as we develop.

Should anyone have any products or their own personal systems they want to be reviewed, should you have any ideas or even if you were thinking about buying a particular product but you are not totally sure, then please drop me an E mail and I will see what I can do about getting a review set up for you. At the end of the day its better we do a review rather than you end up paying for a system that is crap and you end up out of pocket.

Why Gamble/Trade?

I would like you to ask yourself when you get 5 minutes, “Why am I gambling or trading?” If your reply is you are doing it for a laugh, a bit of fun etc; then I would question if unsuccessful what is fun about losing money? – Even though that choice is down to each individual.

If however your reply is to make money then please read on, it won't be easy, but it with the right mentality planning and overall approach etc; it is more than possible to make very good profits and a very good living from gambling

Without going in to much detail here you need to treat this like a business, you need to plan everything you intend to do.

For those of you have already signed up to the gambling academy and are waiting for the next newsletter, Ian has informed me that they are virtually ready to go and will resume in the New Year, he just needs to update a couple of things.

Mentality of Gamblers/Traders/Bettors!!!

In my opinion this is the fundamental downfall of most losing bettors, I myself have suffered with this problem and still today have to fight myself to do the right things the right way day after day.

Like more than one thing within in our personal life, humanity as a whole always seem to generally be after the quick fix, be honest with yourself – whether you're trying to get fit, loose weight or making money etc are you after the quick answer – do you want results in a week? - Gambling is no different.

Who here would be happy to take £100.00 and with careful planning, organisation and putting a fair amount of time in, turn that in to £500.00 within 12 months? – I would take a guess and say many will come back with “Not much point in that, I would hope to make more than that” however you do the same process for 5 years and you will have over £300,000.00 and you would be able to sustain a very comfortable lifestyle.

Now with the original question in mind who would be happy to turn £100.00 in to £300,000.00 within 5 years? I would imagine the majority would be happy with that and yet most people will struggle to make the first step – This is purely a hypothetical example; but something worth thinking about.

It is better to make £5 profit for the year, then end up losing £500/£1000 or £2000 a year through bad habits, such as over-staking, to many bets etc;

You should always bet and trade to win, but bet and trade at the right times, with the right plan – don't bet just for the sake of betting.

With the majority of losing bettors and traders it's either one or a combination of the following reasons why you will end up losing long term:

- Not understanding what you are doing – no betting and trading plan, both short and long term plans and goals.
- Over exposure, on any particular bet or trade (play within your limits) – If you had a betfair bank of £25,000 would you risk £8750 on a bet – I doubt it very much! And yet I am sure many people would have a £100 bank and risk £35 exactly the same ratio – just different figures – Get the basics right from day 1. No matter how big or small the amount always respect your money.
- Too many bets - Don't bet for the sake of it.
- Having a losing day/week or month and dumping the system you are following for something else – only to find a month later the system you have just dumped has had a really good run and has responded well and overall is in profit.

Winning Mentality

A winning mentality is crucial if you want to be a successful bettor, I have recently had many conversations with Ian, and it doesn't take long to pick up on why this guy will always win long term.

I have spoken to Ian after both very good and bad weekends and weekdays and the guy is exactly the same – if he has had a good day betting he doesn't swing from the chandeliers and likewise if he has had a bad day, he doesn't turn round and say “not today Kieran, I have had a bad day's betting” – this comes down to the fact that Ian knows that long term if he keeps doing the right thing he will always win.

For anyone serious about there betting, whether you have been betting for 5 minutes or 5 years whether you made a profit or loss last year, for anyone who wants to change their mentality to that of a winning bettor I would strongly recommend you sign up to Ian's Newsletters, I have mentioned it earlier on but the information in the Newsletters will be more important than anything I or any system will ever be able to offer you, because the information you will get from them will be able to offer you a strong foundation to work from.

Like anything or anyone successful in any walk of life you have to get the fundamentals right first, your foundations set-up.

These newsletters will offer you everything from money management, mentality, how to form your own books, advice from successful traders.... The list goes on... Like any trade in life, accountant, electrician, mechanic, plumber you have to learn your skill first – These newsletters will get you on the way to doing this and for those more experienced gamblers and traders they will offer a refresher.

Betting System Reviews!!

I will make every effort to find the real betting and trading gems that are out there and make them available to the FTS Community, so many of us can make a profit, let me assure you we are in this together, there will be products out that are reviewed that I will be looking to use myself.

Before you sign up for any product that we may recommend in the future I would like you to take a few moments to think about what you are doing and the risks and rewards involved.

When we review a product we will do for a set period of time, this will usually be between 30 – 90 days, we are confident that by doing this, it will give us a good idea if the product will produce a decent long term profit, this however does not guarantee success, but you can rest assured though we will always give an honest assessment of each individual product.

So everyone is clear there are a few basic guidelines and ideas that myself and Ian have agreed to;

- Offer an honest and reliable service – highlight both the good and bad products and services.
- Put up daily selections for all services being reviewed, I will aim to have these up by 1pm everyday on both the website under System Trials and also on the forum
- I will aim to update all the results daily, there may be the odd couple of days a week where they are not updated, but the results will never get far behind. The most important thing is the selections are posted before the event for transparency
- All trials will run for a period of either 30/60/90 days - to be precise this will actually be calendar months, January, February, March and so on.
- All trials will start on the 1st of each month our first full batch of trials and reviews will start on the 1st Jan 2012, we don't want to get in to a situation where we are running too many trials to cope with, so for the first 2 or 3 months, we will be running with a one in, one out system. As soon as we finish reviewing one system another one will start. – The reason we are doing this, is so we don't find ourselves 2 months down the road and we are losing track of results etc; It has to be a solid service that is given to the FTS Community.
- To begin with we are going to send out regular monthly newsletters that will offer everyone an overview of all that has happened in the previous month. This will include full monthly results for all products under review, an overview from us if we recommend any of them, or whether we think we need more time to make an informed decision, we will also let you know of new system trials that are being launched for the following month.
- As time goes on and we get a well run operation going we will look to increase the amount of trials and reviews that are happening during any given period.

I would like to highlight a couple of important information:

This will be broken in to 2 sections;

Systems Trials: This is a section where we review and trial new ideas and systems; for example if anyone has an idea or system they have been using themselves with success we will review it and should it be solid, we will make it available to the FTS members – should this apply to you, you can E mail me to discuss further.

Betting Systems Review: Under this section we review betting and trading products that are already available. We will try and find out if they work, does the product do what the author claims and so on. In Fairness to the author of all products, we will only do reviews of products, with weekly and monthly updates; we cannot put selections up before the event due to protecting the service provider and people who are already subscribed to a service.

We have many other ideas we plan to implement over the coming weeks, and will continue to update you all in due course.

A Solid Start – Being Realistic

I think it's important that people realise that with the right planning over a period of time you can make a decent amount of profit.

If this was me starting out on the 1st January 2012 I personally would make a plan and for me it would go along something of these lines; -

- The first thing I would do is sign up to the Gambling Academy, I have mentioned this before, but the value of these cannot be understated.
- I would then personally sign up to Bonus Bagging. Bonus bagging for those who are not aware is a way to make virtually risk free money – it won't make you rich, but it will give you a decent amount of money to start with and a decent betting bank to get you going.
- From the 1st January I would follow the Daily Trial Selections – and see what systems prove successful and then decide which ones suit my betting portfolio.
- I would then with the money I have made from bonus bagging, fund myself and follow whatever systems I decided to sign up for, with a view to making myself a long term a steady income.

This is just a real basic example but hopefully highlights the importance of planning.

Finally I would like to add a couple of other points, which are relevant to this:

If anyone is under the impression that we are going to review products, you can then sign up, put a £100 in your betfair account and make £50,000 within 6 months, you are mistaken.

I am sure we will recommend products that don't turn out as we had hoped, some products will not do as well as we thought they would, while others will exceed our expectations.

I am aware in the past that products have been recommended that have not turned out to be successful, but we have many that have turned out to be very successful and will continue to do so, such as Horsebacks, Green streaks etc; like every business you will not get everything right, we are no different but we will certainly get more things right than wrong.

I will say all the best to everyone, if you do things right you will get the results you deserve, but it will take time effort and mental toughness. I won't say good luck, because winners don't rely on luck, we rely on hard work and discipline.

Trials Running & New Trials Starting 1st January 2012

As I mentioned before we have some trials that will be starting the 1st January 2012, we also have a couple of trials that started before the 1st January and I will detail these below.

Under 1.5 Lays: The provider has informed me he has been making steady long term profits from his selections for a long time and wishes to submit his selections for review, there is no trading just simply place your lay bet and let it run, as the title suggest its simply laying the Under 1.5 score line. Handicapped Lays: The provider sends me each morning a series of horses to lay with a well set out staking plan. There is no trading and it is a laying service. I have been trialling this service for around 3 weeks so far and we will continue to monitor to see how it works out. The initial signs look promising and a Starting bank of £1000 now stands at over £2000, I personally have real high hopes for this service. JK Sports Trading: The providers are 2 guys, who are building up a solid reputation for themselves – A.K.A. Koda Trades, I have e-mailed them personally and asked them to introduce there product and they sent me the following: Koda Trades was founded by two traders at the back end of May 2011. The traders, Koda and Jasper (code names), met whilst members of a trading information service. A trading information service is one which supplies information about the day's sporting events, then it's down to the person reading the information to decide whether to trade or not. Whilst recommended trades were supplied their performance was poor, so Koda and Jasper decided to form their own trading service focussed on tips, not on information.

The service they run is based on value. So, if according to their research the real odds should be 3.5, but the available odds are 3.0 that could mean a lay bet may be advised. Of course, not every trade will be a winner therefore exit points are advised in order to reduce liability. Koda and Jasper spend a lot of time researching, hence the reason why little information is supplied with tips.

The service is free for one year as they feel that is the minimum amount of time required to know whether the markets they trade are proving profitable or not. Once a full year has been completed they will then consider the possibility of going subscription only, a profit of 60 points to 3 points liability per trade is their target for the first year, and they are half-way already. TheSpecial1 Killer: The FTS Forum was stirred up just before 2012 when a new member came along and made many claims, which we all hope to be true, with the amount of controversy caused I have agreed to review his selections to find out “If his results do what the provider claims”. We will see but it will certainly be interesting to follow, these will be straight bets to follow and the provider will start with a £1000 bank, I must add his initial selections look very promising, so everyone please watch this space with interest. Correct Scores Lays: Ian has been tracking this system personally for a few months and the results have been very impressive and consistent, in the interest of fairness and to offer a totally transparent service I am going to start tracking it myself from the 1st of January, the provider will send me a number of selections (that he feels fit his criteria) and with these selection we lay the Correct Score Market at half time, so whatever the score in the game is at Half Time we lay. However as part of the providers rules we always lay @ 4.0, if the market price is higher to lay at half time, then we put our bet in and wait for it to be matched, if a goal goes in before the bet doesn't qualify, but after tracking this myself the bet usually gets matched within the first 5/10 minutes of the second half. Betting System Reviews:

We will also be conducting some reviews, and I have outlined these below. Golf Bet Profits 2012: We have a late comer to our trial section and as the title suggest it's a golf service. An FTS member will analyse upcoming tournaments post his thoughts and then his recommended bets. I will include his analyses as well as his bets, we will work this service from a 100 point bank, for the trial purpose as usual the bank will start at £1000. The Trial/review can be viewed here:

Total Football Trading: Total Football Trading, provides us with 10 manuals with different strategies, however they don't send out selections so it's not suited to a typical trial format. When you sign up you get full access to a member's area as well as access to all the trading strategies. The members will also include a support forum as well as bonus strategies. This is mainly aimed at those who are at a novice to

intermediate level with their football trading. In the interest to make this an honest assessment, I am going to do an introduction, then I am going to ask a novice trader to have a look over this so they can tell me how easy it was to pick up, I will then myself go over all the manuals and make sure they offer sound advice to work from. TWADJ: (Trading with a Day Job): We have been reviewing a trading system for the past couple of weeks on the recommendation of a FTS member. He has sent me the following overview and I will start posting his results up in the coming days and weeks. The review can be viewed at the following link:

Following overview has been sent to me, which I have kept word for word.

Starting on Jan 1, I am trialling a quite clever trading system in the Forex/CFD-area.

Although the Forex/CFD market can seem daunting at first, this system is designed for those with little or no experience. (And you will get plenty of instructions on how to get started and get going).

The system is called Trading with a Day Job.

Trading with a day job (TWADJ) is specifically designed for the person who works at daytime and only has a little spare time in the afternoon/evening.

It is designed by a clever chap named Nick and I have during a couple of months now had invaluable help with every question regarding the system and almost everything else as well.

Trialling a Forex-system is tricky, since it is really up to the trader how much profit you'll take – what your nerve stands.

I've found that the TWADJ-system has a very high hit-rate, and I'll add or deduct 25 pips from the total. Note, you can often gain more than 25 pips, but you shall NEVER lose more than 25.

Now, the author says that 20 pips per day is enough (and it certainly is), we must compensate for the days when the winnings are 40+ or more pips, thus we do it simple and say 25 pips either way. Clear?

You are not required to know anything about the market to trade with TWADJ, but with this system you will get A LOT to read. A lot regarding trading psychology, theory and practice. Nick also suggests you to 60 paper trades before you move on to real money, and that is very recommended.

Although it is a lot to read, the system is quite brilliant yet simple. Almost a 'if this happens – do that'-system. Easy for the review.

Even if we should only get 20 pips per day, I'll look out and review all trades during the day (usually 3-5) and take them all in to account.

I'll also comment a little if there was anything extraordinary happening.

Summary:

Overall I anticipate 2012 being a great year for all those involved with FTS who are prepared to look long term and play with discipline and have the correct mental approach. Myself and Ian will be spending many hours working together to get you good services, we will also be looking to highlight the crap out there that many providers keep trying to push out. Things are moving along nicely and we are really looking to speed things up over the coming months.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all again for your patience, also thank all those who have E-mailed me with offers of help and for those who I have not replied to yet, rest assured, I will be in contact in the coming weeks to take you up on your offer.

I know many have E-mailed me with systems they would like reviewing and believe me I will get through them all in the coming weeks and months – I actually have around 150 + products and systems that need reviewing and the list is ever growing.

I will be speaking with Ian over the coming days and weeks and I will look to get my next newsletter out by the end of January, to give everyone an update of how these trials have continued and to introduce more trials that will be starting the 1st February.
